Official visit of District Governor Rtn. H.L.Ravi

Our weekly meeting of 18th August was the official visit of our District Governor. Number of activities were planned and executed on the day.



A grand function was arranged at Rotary Centre. The Governor was welcomed to our club at 8.30AM. This was followed by breakfast and lighting the lamp. Members of our club joined the event with Go-Green T-Shirts. After lightning the lamp Governor visited our Rotary Children's Library Association and wrote in the visitor's book that this was one of the best Children's library he had ever come across. Rtn. PP. Ajay Kumar Singh, Rtn. Lokeshwaraiah and Rtn. K.C.Sathish welcomed the Governor.



The event was followed by Rotary Ramya Awards for Excellence in Social Service. This award instituted in 1994 is given to an organisation/individual and this year the award has been given to "Ajitha Nele" serving the street children and rehabilitating the street children by providing accommodation and education. A citation and Rs. 10000/8- was given to the President of the trust Sri.Gopala Krishna. Smt Leelavathi secretary spoke on the occasion and requested the members to participate in their activities. A sum of Rs.52000/- was collected by members for the construction of their new building.

Our next programme was a pledge on Eye Donation “1000 Partners – 1 Million Pledges”. A brochure was released and a link was activated by our District Governor in the Rotary Mysore Website. Mrs. Madura of Mysore Eye Bank was felicitated on this occasion and a purse was given to her treatment. She has been involved in this eye donation project in Mysore and here services were remembered. Mr. Jayaram of Nayana Joythi Trust with whom Rotary Mysore is associated spoke on this occasion. It was a very heart rendering event.

Club Assembly: Governor H.L.Ravi carried out the club assembly where various issues were discussed, discussion was also held on the 5 Avenues of Service, Matching Grants, and the District projects. He requested members to contribute liberally to Rotary Foundation so that our club becomes a 100% PHF club.



The Governor next visited our Ideal Jawa Rotary Primary School and planted a tree to commemorate the visit of the Governor. He was very much impressed at the activities and the facilities available at the school. This was followed by the next programme a Limb Camp.



This was a very big function organised on the day of Governor’s visit. There were 32 beneficiaries; many of them had lost when working in the agriculture fields and due to diabetes. It was a happy moment to see the beneficiaries able to walk after the fitment. We had invited the important people of Mysore for the function and honoured some of them who have been supporting the cause. The centre is 12 years

old and so far carried out many numbers of camps and has provided 5200 limbs to the needy. Many of our Rotarians and well wishers of the project contributed to cause. Nearly 2 lakhs were endorsed by the donors on this occasion.



Governor was taken to our Rotary High School where the students were addressed by the Governor and he also inaugurated the Aero-Dreamz-2011 at the School.



The Blood Bank was visited by Governor Fruits and biscuits were distributed to the patients and the Four Way Test at the hospital was inaugurated. The Governor appreciated our concern to the society by providing the state of the Art Blood Bank at Chandrakala Hospital and released a sticker on our Blood Bank to be displayed at all medical shops, Public Health Centers and hospitals. Rtn. B.S. Ravi Kumar has sponsored for the stickers.



Rotaract Club of NIE Science Collage: After lunch Governor installed the New Office Bearers of the Rotaract Mysore of NIE Science collage and addressed them. A seed amount of Rs4000/- were given by the members of Rotary Mysore and requested the members to use the forum to develop leadership skills and also so some meaningful projects at least two in a year and also to invite good guest speaker to address them.



The Evening function of Governor was in the new Auditorium of our Rotary High School. The stage was well decorated and after the president called the meetings to order number of projects were announced. Club Service: Dr. A.S.Bawa, Director DFRL was inducted as our Honorary Rotarian for the year 2011-12.



Community Service: Rs.25000/- was given to Sneha Kirana Spastic Society for procuring special chairs for the spastic students.

Rs. 10000/- was given to MRC Eye Hospital to carryout a mega project on Contract operation to the rural people at their hospital.

New Generation: An appeal for contribution to our New Integrated School Project costing Rupees five crores was released.

Dictionaries worth Rs. 70000/- was officially launched. It will be distributed to 700 Government aided and non aided high schools. These are English to Kannada and will be kept in the schools for reference by the teachers and students. The project has been launched by district 3190 the books are given at subsidized price of Rs100/-. Rotary Brigade has promised to give 50 books free of cost for every 300 books as a joint project with them. We thank Rtn. Akshay of Rotary Brigade associated personally in this project.

International Service: Governor recognized Rtn. Vijay Shah and Rtn. Diwakarkanth for contributing towards PHF.

PHF medallions were given away by governor to Rtn. Ravi Shankar N, and Rtn. Bipin Shah.

This was followed by the release of special bulletin by Assistant Governor and the Governor address by Governor H.L.Ravi. Who was in all praise of the activities of our club.
